Join with hundreds of other walkers to fight poverty step by step

In 2007, Christian Aid's Indian partner, Ekta Parishad, organised 25,000 people to march 320 km to Delhi to demand that the government take action on land rights for the landless poor. In many ways the march was a success, but the progress since has been slow. So, Ekta Parishad have announced an even larger march in 2012, with 100,000 people taking part. This will be preceded by 24 regional marches starting in Kerala in October 2011.

March for Justice is our opportunity to stand in solidarity with the farmers as they march. The Indian farmers will be putting aside two handfuls of rice a week for a year so they will have food to eat on the march. We are looking for church leaders to take part in our walks. Our walkers will be finding sponsors who will put aside £2 a week for the year between the two walks to support the work of Christian Aid's partners in India. (Of course, more traditional sponsorship is welcome too!).
